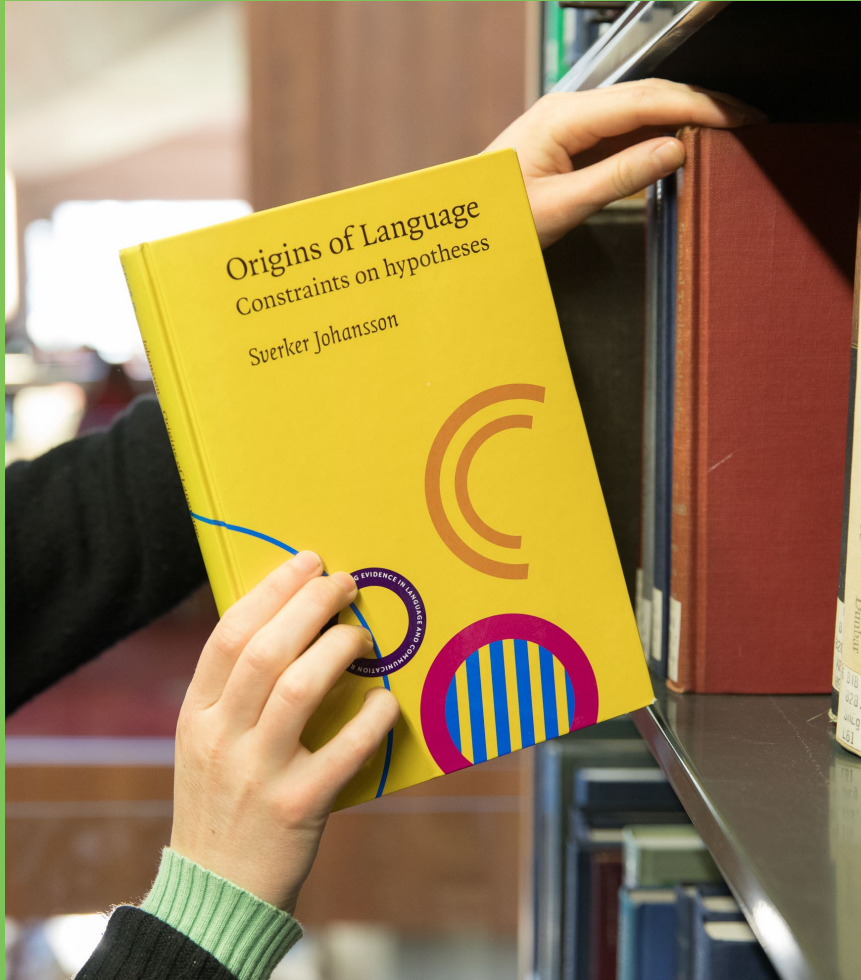
USING THE LIBRARY

POSTGRADUATE BORROWING

Higher Degree (Research/Taught Masters/PhD)

- You can borrow up to **50 books** at any one time from the General Lending collection, which can include items from our open shelves or from storage.
- Items can be borrowed for 12 weeks and renewed **once for a further 12 weeks**, as long as nobody else has placed a recall on the item

FINDING A PRINT BOOK ON THE SHELF



Use the **Library Catalogue** to identify where your book is located

Codes (shelfmarks) are assigned to books to help you locate them on the shelves. The shelfmark is visible on a white shelf mark label attached to the cover of the book


New! You can now request to collect books on the shelves from the Library Service Desk closest to its home – what we call *Click and Collect*. You can still go to the shelf yourself!

90% of our collection is in storage (on and offsite) – you request nearly all of these using Click and Collect

USING THE LIBRARY

CLICK AND COLLECT

- **Normal Library shelves (within 24 hours, often much sooner) NOTE: you can only collect from the Service Desk where the book is located!**
- **Ussher Stacks (within 24 hours, often much sooner) – normally, any Service Desk**
- **Santry and External Storage (generally next weekday) – normally, any Service Desk**
- Other materials must be requested using a call slip (ask at our service desks)
- All material can be requested to the reading room for consultation and most can be borrowed

eBOOKS – UK eLD & REGULAR eBOOKS

UK legislation means that the electronic versions of legal deposit material must be accessed at designated PCs in the Library

You can access the ebooks we purchase (regular ebooks) from anywhere. Most appear in the Library Catalogue - start there! – but some are in Articles and More

TOP TIPS

- ✓ CONTACT your Subject Librarian for expert searching advice
- ✓ ATTEND a Library HITS class and brush up on your research skills
- ✓ SEARCH for books on your reading list or any topic using the Library Catalogue
- ✓ INSTALL Lean Library to find the full text of articles via Google or Google Scholar
- ✓ BORROW up to 50 books at a time
- ✓ REQUEST books from the shelves or storage using the Click and Collect service
- ✓ USE the Self-Service Kiosks to borrow or return books
- ✓ PRINT/COPY/SCAN on any printer (service managed by Datapac). ID code = your student number; PIN e-mailed when you register with TCD
